Bill Skardinski addressed the Board regarding Local Law #4 of 2004 (junk ordinance). Mr. Skardinski realizes that the Town and Village share the code officer and asked if we (village) get their \$9,000.00 worth. Mayor Platten explained the duties of the code enforcement officer and believes he is fulfilling his duty.

The local law has flaws and the Village attorney is working on this to make it have more stringent consequences. Discussion followed.

Mr. Ingersol stated that the snowplow has ruined the lawn area near the road and it hasn't been repaired yet.

Mayor Platten will share concern of the difference between "weeds" and "grass" with legal counsel.

Shannon Stevens addressed the Board regarding "The Works" tavern. It had been good for a couple of weeks, but now it's starting to get loud again. Mrs. Stevens went into detail of some of the events that have occurred there.

Mr. Ingersol said the vehicles from "The Works" speed up Lawrence St. He said that after one incident he called the State Troopers and they never stopped.

Mayor Platten told them they need to call 911 when an incident occurs so there is a report made. Mayor Platten will contact Sgt. Siddall about the concerns.

Trustee Ferris supported Mayor Platten's suggestion to call 911 as she has had to do so while working at the bank after feeling threatened.

Mayor Platten and the Board thanked all for sharing their concerns.
